COVID-19: HYGIENE PROTOCOL

General Hygiene guidelines: It is the players responsibility to follow and respect the governmental guidelines at any time while attending the tournament. Please see the following guidelines at a glance:

- i. Social distancing at any time. Stay a minimum of 1,5m away from any person.
- ii. Wash your hands thoroughly.
- iii. Please use your arm/elbow while sneezing or coughing.
- iv. Do not touch, shake hands or hug any other person.
- v. Make sure to pre inform yourself about regulations of the respective golf club and follow the guidelines at any time.
- vi. Wear a facemask when entering the clubhouse, pro shop or any other building of the golf course.
- vii. Do not touch your face with your hands.
- viii. Make sure to fill out an attendance document.
- ix. Book your practice round prior to attending the tournament through the golf club. Do not attend the official practice round, if you have not pre booked you practice round at the respective golf club.
- x. Please use only your own golf balls or clubs while practicing. Do not touch a ball or a club of a different person.
- xi. A player needs to be present at a max. of 10 min before his practice round or the tournament round has started at the respective. Only the playing group needs to be allocated.

COVID-19: TRAVEL INFO

It is a player's responsibility to check any governmental restrictions in his home country or the country/state the player is planning on to play the tournament. Pro Golf Events or GJG cannot give any info on travel restrictions as these may differ from country to country. Please make sure to inform yourself thoroughly, before you start traveling, that you are aware of any restrictions or guidelines opposed by the government due to the threat by Covid 19.

COVID-19: IMPORTANT NEW REGISTRATION TOOL

In the past a player had to be present in the tournament office or sent an email to confirm his participation on the OFFICIAL PRACTICE ROUND DAY according to Tour Rule #18. This will be currently not more applicable due to the SAFETY/HYGIENE Protocol. There will instead be an ONLINE REGISTRATION tool in your *GJG player's account* (Login: <https://ssl.globaljuniorgolf.com/member/index.php?modul=member &lang=en>). Please check **3 DAYS** before the tournament in your players account under YOUR TOURNAMENTS. Here you will find the instructions to confirm participation. Please do not forget this process otherwise you will NOT be listed in the tournament. An automatic confirmation email will be sent to your account email, confirming once you have finished the process accordingly.

1. Schedule and format

The event takes place at Drentsche Golf & Country Club (DG&CC) - <http://www.dgcc.nl>. The Tulip Golf Challenge is an individual strokeplay event played over 54 holes with no cut. Players will play 18 holes on each tournament day starting on Friday October 14th 2022. The official practice round will take place on Thursday 13th of October 2022.

2. Conditions of Competition

- > The tournament will be held in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited, the actual rules of the Dutch Golf Federation approved by the tournament committee and the GJG Hard Card.
- > The local rules will be published, handed out on the first tee and be visible on the tournament notice board at the venue.
- > The competition is deemed to be closed when the trophy has been presented. Play will not be extended beyond Sunday 16th of October.
- > All players accept that photos made during the tournament will be published.
- > The free practice round can be booked via: martin@progolfevents.nl
- > Boys will play from the white tees and girls will play from the blue tees.

3. Qualifying Event

The competition is a handicap qualifying event and according to the GJG eligibility.

4. Eligibility to play

This event is co-sanctioned between the GJG Tour and 21golffleague and is open to amateur golfers, both boys and girls. **IMPORTANT**; Entries are based on first come first serve within the eligibility criteria!

A. In the age classes

GJG Tour players age 12 - 18 (max. 18 at the start of the event)

23golffleague players age 18 - 21 (max. 23 at the start of the event)

B. All players must be members of a registered golf club.

C. Handicap limit

Boys: 5

Girls: 8

D. Tees

Boys: White

Girls: Blue

5. Number of entries

The Tulip Golf Challenge can handle no more than 84 participants. The tournament committee reserves the right to change / limit the size of the field. One third of the field will be designated for girls.

6. Prizes

- Numbers 1 – 3 gross for both boys and girls in GJG tour
- Numbers 1 – 3 gross for both boys and girls in 23 Golf League

The award ceremony will take place in the clubhouse 30 minutes after conclusion of play.

7. Entries

Application for participation is only possible for members of the Global Junior Tour and 21golfligue.

8. Closing date of entries

Tuesday 13th of September 2022.

Breakfast will be provided in the clubhouse of the Drentsche Golf & Country Club.
