Tournament Information

1. Schedule and Format:

The event takes place at

5 Sintra, Portugal

This is a 54 Hole individual stroke play event. 18 Holes per day, commencing on February 05th 2023. Official practice round February 04th 2023.

2. Eligibility to play - The competition is a handicap qualifying event, where players are accepted "first come, first served within the eligibility criteria!:

This event is co-sanctioned between the GJG Tour and 23golffleague and is open to amateur golfers, both boys and girls

a) In the age classes

- GJG Tour players age 12-18 (max. 18 at the start of the event)
- 23golffleague age 19-23 (max. 23 at the start of the event)
- U14 (please note players will tee off from different tee boxes and will not be listed in the WAGR Ranking according to Tour Rule #19.4)
- All players need to become a GJG Tour member or 23golffleague member

- a) All players must be members of a registered golf club
- b) Handicap limit: **Boys 5 / Girls 7 → U14 Boys 15 / U14 Girls 20 (Remember to update your HCP according to WHS)**
- c) If a player is not meeting the HCP limits or has no GJG eligibility status, please send a wildcard inquiry to service@globaljuniorgolf.com with latest tournaments results. The tournament committee has 10 wildcards available.

3. Field Size

The field will be capped at **90 competitors**. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to change or limit the size of the field. **IMPORTANT: players will be allocated „first come, first serve“!**

WAITING LIST: Once the tournament has reached its max. number of participants, a waiting list will be in place. Players will be allocated based on their entry date on the waiting list and the order can be found on the respective tournament page. If a player gets confirmed from the waiting list due

to cancellations, than a player must react within 24hours to confirm his spot. If a player will not react within 24hours, he loses his spot and the next on the waiting list will be confirmed.

4. Entry Closing Date and Procedures

5.1 Entries close on January 04th 2023;

All players must be or become a member of **Global Junior Golf**. International players may request early confirmation of entry to help with international travel bookings. **A player is only accepted at the tournament once he either has paid the tournament package or the Entry Fee in full with the host Penha Longa!**

5.2 Late entries may be accepted at the sole discretion of the Tournament Committee

5. Travel Info

It is a player's responsibility to check any governmental restrictions in his home country or the country/state the player is planning on to play the tournament. GJG cannot give any info on travel restrictions as these may differ from country to country. Please make sure to inform yourself thoroughly, before you start traveling, that you are aware of any restrictions or guidelines opposed by the government due to the threat by Covid 19.

6. Prizes

1 – 3 gross for both boys and girls in **23 golfleague (age 23 at start of event & under)**. In this category **every player will tee off** and the **overall winner boys and girls of the Portuguese Intercollegiate Open** will be determined.

1 – 3 gross for both boys and girls in **GJG Tour (age 18 at the start of the event & younger)**

1 – 3 gross for both boys and girls in **U14 (age 14 at the start of the event & younger)**

7. Registration

In the past a player had to be present in the tournament office or sent an email to confirm his participation on the OFFICIAL PRACTICE ROUND DAY. This will be currently not more available due to the SAFETY/HYGIENE Protocol. There will be instead an ONLINE REGISTRATION tool in your **GJG players account**

(Login: <https://ssl.globaljuniorgolf.com/member/index.php?modul=member&lang=en>). Please check **3DAYS** before the tournament in your players account under YOUR TOURNAMENTS. Here you will find the instructions to confirm participation. Please do not forget this process otherwise you will NOT be listed in the tournament. An automatic confirmation email will be sent to your account email, confirming once you have finished the process accordingly.

8. Practice Rounds

9.1 The official tournament practice round is 04th February. To book an official practice round time please contact directly the golf club reservas.golf@penhalonga.com

9.2 All official practice times booked will be allocated on a first come first served basis. These times are open only for players participating in the tournament. Parents are not allowed to join and play alongside the players during the official practice round

9. Package & Entry Fee Options

Global Junior Golf does not take any liability for any bookings. A player must book directly through the host Penha Longa Golf Resort. Global Junior Golf does not manage any bookings!

Important:

Every player has the option to choose between either a package or Entry Fee!

Before choosing a tournament package players need to register through the GJG system and need to be accepted by the host or GJG!

Please note that 15 rooms at the Penha Longa Resort are reserved and will be given out on „First come, First serve Basis!

The local rules will be published and posted on the tournament notice board at the venue, given out on the starting tee and will be available on the tournament website! The competition is deemed to be closed when the ONLINE Ceremony has been finished. Play will not be extended beyond the 08th of February.
