- 1. Out of Bounds (Rule 18.2)**
 - (a) A ball is out of bounds when it is any wall, fence, or line of white stakes defining a boundary
 - (b) On Hole 1-9, the out of bounds is defined by the inside edge of the road (playing side)
 - (c) On Hole 14, the out of bounds is defined by the white racing fence
 - (d) On Hole 18, the out of bound continues along the inside edge of the curb
 - 2. Penalty Areas (Rule 17)**
 - (a) All penalty Areas are Red
 - (b) Any unmarked Penalty Area is automatically Red
 - (c) Drop Zones: On Holes 8 & 17, the drop zones are an additional option to Rule 17
 - 3. Abnormal Course Conditions (Rule 16)**

Immovable Obstructions

 - (a) All artificial surfaces in the general area
 - (b) Floodlights
 - (c) Staked trees and tree wells
 - (d) All fixed irrigation pipes, sprinkler head and control boxes

Ground Under Repair

 - (a) All areas marked by a white line
 - 4. Floodlights**

Any ball striking any part of the floodlights should be played as it lies
 - 5. MLR E-12**

When taking Back-on-line Relief, this MLR is in operation
 - 6. MLR G-9**

Replacement of a club that is broken or significantly damaged, this MLR is in operation
 - 7. Hard Edge**

If your ball comes to rest up against the hard edge in the sandy waste area and it interferes with your stance or the line of your intended swing, you may drop the ball at the nearest point of relief within one club length, not nearer the hole, but must remain within the sandy waste area I Rule 16.1A

- All Yardages are measured to the center of the green
