TOURNAMENT INFO 2025

1. Schedule and format

The event takes place at The Links Valley - <https://www.thelinksvalley.nl>. The GJG Dutch Juniors International is an individual strokeplay event played over 54 holes with a cut after 36 holes:

- Players will play **36 holes** (round 1 & 2) on Wednesday April 23rd 2025;
- The **top 8 girls** (lowest 8 scores plus ties) and **top 20 boys** (lowest 20 scores plus ties) qualify for the final round on Thursday April 24th 2025;
- During the final round players will play strokeplay over 18 holes.

The official practice round will take place on Tuesday April 22nd 2025.

2. Conditions of Competition

The tournament will be held in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited, the actual rules of the Dutch Golf Federation (NGF) approved by the tournament committee and the GJG Hard Card. The local rules will be published and posted on the scorecard and tournament notice board at the venue. The competition is deemed to be closed when the trophy has been presented. Play will not be extended beyond Thursday April 24th 2025.

- All players accept that photos made during the tournament will be published.
- The practice round (Tuesday April 22nd) will be a shotgun start over 18 holes (both directions) starting at 9.00am. All competitors will be in the draft. In case you are not able to play, please contact: henk@progolfevents.nl **IMPORTANT: In case you can't play then you will be allocated at a different day, but have to pay an additional greenfee!**

3. Qualifying Event

The competition is a handicap qualifying event and according to the GJG eligibility.

4. Eligibility to play

This event is co-sanctioned between the GJG Tour and 23golfligues and is open to amateur golfers, both boys and girls. **IMPORTANT**; Entries are based on first come first serve within the eligibility criteria!

A. In the age classes:

age 12 - 23 (max. 23 at the start of the event)

All players need to become a GJG Tour member or 23golfligues member.

B. All players must be members of a registered golf club.

C. Handicap limit:

Boys: 5

Girls: 9

D. Tees:

Boys: White

Girls: Blue

5. Number of entries

The GJG Dutch Juniors International can handle no more than 48 participants. The tournament committee reserves the right to change / limit the size of the field.

6. Prizes

- Numbers 1 – 5 gross for both boys and girls
- **SPECIAL PRIZE:**
- **1st Overall Boys & Girls gets free wildcard for Holbox Junior Open & Tulip Golf Challenge**
- **2nd Overall Boys & Girls gets a free wildcard for Golfodge Junior Open**

In the event of more than one player recording the same winning score a hole-by-hole play-off, will take place over holes to be designated by the Tournament Committee to determine a winner. Should a play-off not be possible for whatever reason, the winner will be determined as follows:

6.1 The player recording the lowest final round score, if this is not conclusive, then;

6.2 matching scorecards over the last 9, 6, 3, 2, 1 holes (Note: Holes 10 to 18 are considered to be the last holes regardless of the starting tee of the competitor) of the final round. If it is still a tie, the winner will be determined by lot.

6.3 In the case of prizes for players on prize winning scores (2nd to 3rd place), in each Competition, all ties will be decided as outlined in 6.1. and 6.2 above.

7. Entries

Application for participation is only possible for members of the Global Junior Golf Tour 6 23golfl league.

8. Closing date of entries

Saturday March 22nd 2025.

9. Entry fee

- **Players Lunch following the practice round**
- Two or three tournament rounds (depending on cut) and one practice round
- Water and fruits during tournament days
- Driving range balls limited time slot

STANDARD RATE: € 200

To confirm your spot on the starting list, all payments MUST be done BEFORE the entry deadline.
