# 1. Schedule and Format:

# WAGR, EGR & JGS ranked\*

This is a 54 Hole individual stroke play event. 18 Holes per day, played from the **18th of June until the 21<sup>sh</sup> of June 2023.** Official practice round is on the 18th of June. Please note that on the last day of the tournament, tee off times will start around 16:00 to 18:00 and the final groups will be finishing around midnight.

# 2. Eligibility to play:

This event is co-sanctioned between the GJG Tour and 21golfleague and is open to amateur golfers, both boys and girls

- a) In the age classes
- GJG Tour players age 12-18 (max. 18 at the start of the event)
- 23golfleague age 18-23 (max. 23 at the start of the event)
- U14 players age 14 and down (max. 14 at the start of the event)
- All players need to become a GJG Tour member U18 or 23golfleague member ( U23 ) Note: Players who participate in the U14 category must register as an U18 member
  - b) All players must be members of a registered golf club
  - c) Handicap limit for: Boys 5 / Girls 7
    U14 category: Boys 10 / Girls 14
  - d) If a player is not meeting the HCP limits or has no GJG eligibility status, please send an wildcard inquiry to <a href="mailto:service@globaljuniorgolf.com">service@globaljuniorgolf.com</a> with latest tournaments results. The tournament committee has 10 wildcards available.

# 3. Field Size

The field will be capped at 72 competitors. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to change or limit the size of the field. IMPORTANT: Players will be allocated "first come, first serve"!WAITING LIST: Once the tournament has reached is max. number of participants, a waiting list will be in place. Players will be allocated based on their entry date on the waiting list and the order can be found on the respective tournament page. If a player gets confirmed from the waiting list due to cancellations, than a player must react within 24hours to confirm his spot. If a player will not react within 24hours, he looses his spot and the next on the waiting list will be confirmed.

## 4. Entry Closing Date and Procedures

## 5.1 Entries close on May 18th 2024;

All players must be or become a member of **Global Junior Golf** on the terms and conditions as determined by GJG. International entries should register directly on the **Global Junior Golf** website. International players may request early confirmation of entry to help with international travel bookings. A player is only accepted at the tournament once he either has paid the tournament package or the Entry Fee in full!

4.2 Late entries may be accepted at the sole discretion of the Tournament Committee; All information required in the entry form must be provided accurately and in full

#### 5. Prizes

- 1-3 gross for both boys and girls in 23 golfleague (age 23 at start of event & under). In this category every player will tee off (besides U14) and the overall winner boys and girls of the Icelandic Midnight Junior Challenge will be determined.
- 1 3 gross for both boys and girls in GJG Tour (age 18 at the start of the event & younger)
- 1 3 gross for both boys and girls in GJG Tour U14

# 8. Cancellation Policy

In the event that a Player, after having registered for a Tournament, cancels his or her participation after the entry deadline or fails, without cancellation, to appear at the Tournament, the registration fee paid shall not be reimbursable. If a player enters for the tournament and fails to show for the tournament without cancellation he or she will be liable to pay the entry fee.

If the cancellation is due to medical reasons and the player is able to present a doctors certificate – 40% of the entry fee will be reimbursed.

The tournament will be held in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited, the actual rules of the Icelandic Golf Federation, the Tour Rules of GJG, GJG Hard Card and the local rules approved by the tournament committee. Make sure to check the Local Rules Info sheet before starting your round. As some of the Tour Rules or GJG Hard Card have been changed due to Corona Virus situation! The local rules will be published and posted on the tournament notice board at the venue, given out on the starting tee and will be available on the tournament website! The competition is deemed to be closed Ceremony has been finished. Play will not be extended beyond the 21st of June.
