Tournament Information

1. Schedule and Format:

The event takes place at

Royal Obidos Golf Resort

Portugal

This is a 54 Hole individual stroke play event. 18 Holes per day, commencing on February 18th 2026.
Official practice round February 17th 2026.

2. Eligibility to play - The competition is a handicap qualifying event, where players are accepted "first come, first served within the eligibility criteria!:"

This event is co-sanctioned between the GJG Tour and 23golfleague and is open to amateur golfers, both boys and girls

a) In the age classes

- U14 players age 16-14 (max. 14 at the start of the event)
- GJG Tour players age 15-18 (max. 18 at the start of the event)
- 23golfleague age 19-23 (max. 23 at the start of the event)
- All players need to become a GJG Tour member or 23golfleague member

b) All players must be members of a registered golf club

c) Handicap limit: **Boys: 7 – Boys U14: 14 / Girls: 9 – Girls U14: 20 (Remember to update your HCP according to WHS)**

- d) If a player is not meeting the HCP limits or has no GJG eligibility status, please send a wildcard inquiry to service@globaluniorgolf.com with latest tournaments results. The tournament committee has 5 wildcards available.

3. Field Size (MAX 60 PLAYERS)

The field will be capped at **60 competitors**. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to change or limit the size of the field. **IMPORTANT: players will be allocated „first come, first serve“!**

WAITING LIST: Once the tournament has reached its max. number of participants, a waiting list will be in place. Players will be allocated based on their entry date on the waiting list and the order can be found on the respective tournament page. If a player gets confirmed from the waiting list due to cancellations, then a player must react within 24 hours to confirm his spot. If a player will not react within 24 hours, he loses his spot and the next on the waiting list will be confirmed.

4. Entry Closing Date and Procedures

5.1 Entries close on January 17th 2026;

All players must be or become a member of **Global Junior Golf**. International players may request early confirmation of entry to help with international travel bookings. **A player is only accepted at the tournament once he has paid the tournament package in full with the host Royal Obidos Golf!**

5.2 Late entries may be accepted at the sole discretion of the Tournament Committee.

5. Travel Info

It is a player's responsibility to check any governmental restrictions in his home country or the country/state the player is planning on to play the tournament. GJG cannot give any info on travel restrictions as these may differ from country to country. Please make sure to inform yourself thoroughly, before you start traveling, that you are aware of any restrictions or guidelines opposed by the government.

6. Prizes

1 – 3 gross for both boys and girls in **23 golfleague (age 23 at start of event & under)**. In this category **every player will tee off** and the **overall winner boys and girls of GJG Portuguese Junior Internationals** will be determined.

1 – 3 gross for both boys and girls in **GJG Tour (age 18 at the start of the event & younger)**

1 – 3 gross for both boys and girls in **U14 (age 14 at the start of the event & younger)**

7. Registration

There is no physical registration on site / A ONLINE REGISTRATION tool in your **GJG players account is provided** (Login: <https://ssl.globaljuniorgolf.com/member/index.php?modul=member&lang=en>). Please check **3DAYS** before the tournament in your players account under YOUR TOURNAMENTS. Here you will find the instructions to confirm participation. Please do not forget this process otherwise you will NOT be listed in the tournament. An automatic confirmation email will be sent to your account email, confirming once you have finished the process accordingly.

8. Practice Rounds

8.1 The official tournament practice round is 17th of February. To book an official practice round time please contact Royal Obidos Golf golf.reservations@royalobidos.com

8.2 All official practice times booked will be allocated on a first come first served basis. These times are open only for players participating in the tournament. Parents are not allowed to join and play alongside the players during the official practice round.
